

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **CITY OF PATERSON NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY FROM ANNUAL ACTION PLAN YEARS 2020-2024**

Annually, the City of Paterson receives entitlement funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME), Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS (HOPWA), and Homeless Emergency Solution Grant (HESG) Programs. HUD requires that the City submit an Annual Action Plan every year.

The purpose of this notice is to inform the public about the need to revise the CDBG budgets for program years 2020-2024; there are unused/leftover funds in the following program years: PY 2020 (\$261,752.10); PY 2021 (\$202,219.78); PY 2022 (\$237,320.57); PY 2023 (\$640,000); and PY 2024 (\$1,119,419). The unused/leftover CDBG funds in the amount of approximately 2.4M is available for **shovel ready public facilities, parks improvements and road resurfacing** eligible projects. The applicant should have a New Jersey Certificate of Good Standing. These CDBG funds must be fully expended by **September 30, 2025**.

All interested non-profit 501(c)(3) agency are encouraged to complete the 2025 CDBG Parks and Public Facilities Improvements application found at the City's website ([www.patersonnj.gov](http://www.patersonnj.gov)), under Community Development. The CDBG application is also available at the Department of Community Development, 125 Ellison Street, 2nd Floor. The completed CDBG application is due back on **Friday, March 14 by 12 Noon** to the Department of Community Development. Please submit one (1) signed original and three (3) copies.
